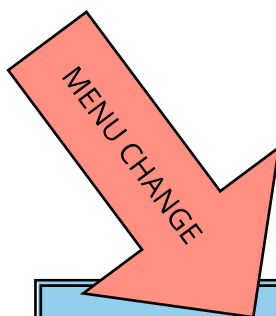

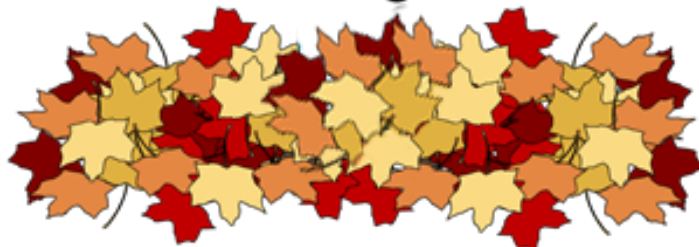

On the 4th week of every month there will be a **menu change**: Teriyaki Dippers will now be Sweet & Sour Chicken for the remainder of the school year.



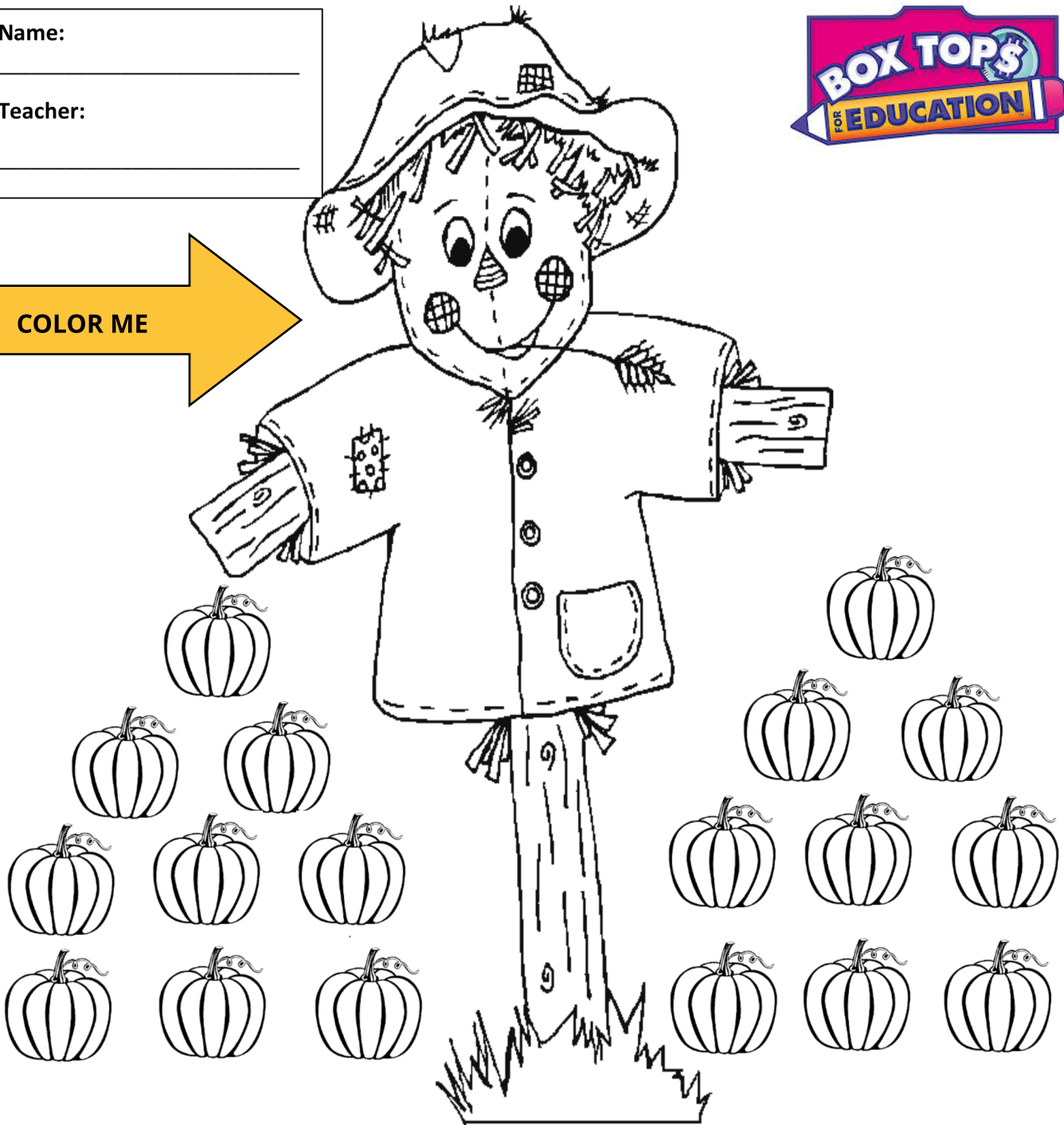

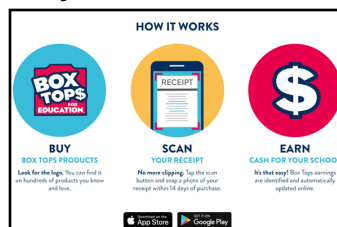
