The CYF CHEERLEADING program provides girls with a fun opportunity to learn cheerleading fundamentals, while also learning about teamwork, sportsmanship and physical fitness in a confidence-building environment. Our program is open to all girls entering grades 1 through 8 in the 2019-20 school year and includes:

- ★ **CHEERLEADING CAMP:** Learn cheerleading skills and fundamentals. All cheerleaders will receive a Cheer Camp T-shirt.
- ★ **FOOTBALL GAME PERFORMANCES:** Cheer for our CYF teams at regular-season and playoff games.
