

## From the Principals desk...

I would like to welcome each new and returning family for Park School for the 2019-2020 school year. Students are quickly getting acclimated to new staff, new routines and new building. Know that we all care about every child and work to provide a safe, academic environment where learning is our most important work.

Please be patient with us as we continue to work through an effective morning drop-off time and afternoon dismissal. With 355 students, 113 pick-ups, latchkey service, walkers and daily changes, know this takes a magnitude of coordination. Parents you must call in no later than **2:45 p.m**. to ensure your student's end of day pick up process. We continue to be concerned with each students safety. Remind your child daily, they must continue to follow the routine you have indicated for them on the end of the day purple pick up sheet. They cannot change or leave school without parental written consent.

### ATTENDANCE IS CRITICAL TO STUDENT LEARNING. WITH THE PASSING OF HB410, ABSENCES ARE CALCULATED IN HOURS, NOT DAYS

- Absent 38 or more hours in a month with or without an excuse – absences will now be calculated in hours not days
- Absent 65 or more hours in a year with or without an excuse

Within 7 days of your child reaching the number of hours identified, you will receive a letter. The school will need to work with you to develop a plan to prevent truancy in the future.

House Bill 410 defines habitual truancy as:

- Absent 30 or more consecutive hours without a legitimate excuse
- Absent 42 or more hours in a month without a legitimate excuse
  Absent 72 or more hours in a year
- Absent 72 or more hours in a yea without a legitimate excuse

In accordance with HB410, parent letters will be sent to identify attendance concerns and an Absence Intervention Plan will need to be implemented to encourage attendance and help foster the academic program.




