BEGINNING OF SCHOOL YEAR THINGS TO REMEMBER

MORNING DROP OFF PROCEDURES:

8:40-9:00 Buses arrive at Hambden

9:00-9:05 Buses unload students to enter the building. There is no supervision until this time.

9:05-9:10 Parent drop off at the side door of the gym. Staff members will be out to assist students getting out of their cars.

9:11 am Students should be in the building

EARLY ARRIVAL AT SCHOOL: Unless they are enrolled in our latchkey program, students should not arrive at school before 9:00 am. If your child misses the bus or must be transported to school by the parent or other car provider for any reason, the child should remain in the car with you or the person who brings your child until 9:05 am. If you do run into an emergency situation, please call the school and we will try to make special arrangements for your child. Normal drop off time is 9:05 am. Thank you for your cooperation.

ATTENDANCE: Please remember that if your child is absent from school, you must call the school by 9:30 a.m. at 286-7503. This will avoid unnecessary concern and phone calling. Thank you for your cooperation.

DISMISSAL: Please remember to call by 2:30 by the end of the day to make any changes to your childs dismissal.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FROM THE SCHOOL NURSE: MEDICATION: If your student requires medication at school, prescription and/or over the counter, a medication form must be completed by the student's parent/guardian and physician before any medication can be administered at school. School Board policy also requires that an adult bring the medication to school in its original container. A new state law allows students who need inhalers or Epipens to carry those medications with them at school. However, a back-up inhaler or Epipen must be supplied to the clinic in self-carry situations. All medication forms may be obtained in the school office/clinic or on the Chardon Local Schools website in the downloads and links area under health service forms.
