Costs for this year's season:

** If you do not have a season's pass ... that's most of you...*

All passes will include rentals! \$203.05 + \$70.00 (bus fee) = \$273.05

** If you have a season's pass ...*

You do NOT need to pay for the lift ticket... only pay \$70.00 (bus fee) = \$70.00

***You do NOT need to register on BMBW's site (step 1 below)*

FAQ's about CHS SKI / SNOWBOARD CLUB

Q: Where do we ski/board at?

A: Brandywine Ski Resort

Q: How many trips do we make?

A: Minimum of 5 ... most likely 6 or 7, weather permitting

Q: What happens if we have a snow day on a Tuesday when we are supposed to ski/board?

A: We will NOT go to Brandywine that day (per district policy). We will make it up so we still get 5 trips... See makeup dates on the front side of this page.

Q: Why is it so expensive?

A: Skiing is an expensive sport but this is actually a great deal! Their school club program is their most heavily discounted program of all the pass options they have. Trust me, I've done the math!

Q: What if I have never skied or snowboarded before?

A: You are in the right spot. This is the perfect time to learn. Convince a friend to learn with you and make some great memories together, plus learn an awesome new sport you can enjoy for the rest of your life!

Q: Does it cost extra for lessons?

A: Nope! You get a 1-hr lesson for the first 5 weeks. They do different levels of lessons based on your ability.

Q: Do I need my own equipment?

A: Nope! It is actually the same price whether you rent or bring your own equipment. So if you are thinking you've always wanted to try the other sport ... this would be a great time to give it a go!

Q: Are there any additional costs once I sign up?

A: Food is not included so you will want to bring money to purchase food at Brandywine lodge. Lockers are also an additional charge (students can purchase a locker token for \$1 each week) and helmets are available for rent at \$10/visit.

Q: What else do I get with my club registration?

A1: Free Long Sleeve CHS Ski Club Shirt ... if you register by the November 20th deadline!

A2: Four \$10 value passes that can be used any day by anyone for (1) an all-day snow pass at BM, BW, or AV, (2) a polar blast snow-tubing session at BW or AV, or (3) a late-night session at BW. Club cards must be presented by you or a parent in order to get the value pass(es) but they may be used by a friend or a family member. You can use multiple value passes at once, if desired.

Also, your club card is still good for the remaining Tuesdays of the season once we stop going as a club!

Q: Oops I changed my mind. I signed up as a skier but want to switch to snowboarding. How do I switch?

A: You CAN'T!

Q: Oops I changed my mind. I signed up as a snowboarder & I want to switch to skiing. How do I switch?

A: You CAN, but only if you switch after the first week ... weird, but that is the policy. I have NO control.

Q: Are we doing a Saturday trip this year to Holiday Valley?

A: Yes! Mark your calendars for Holiday Valley on first weekend in March. This trip will be a separate cost and will be open to non ski-club members. Sign-up information for this trip will be available starting in January (providing the trip is board-approved).

Bus Transportation

All Ski/Board club members are expected to ride the bus on the trips provided. All Ski/Board passes will be issued upon arrival at Brandywine January 7, 2020. The bus fee of \$70.00 must be paid before a pass is distributed.

The following expectations apply to our Tuesday evening trips:

1. The bus will not wait beyond the scheduled departure time of 4:10 pm.
2. The bus will be waiting at the front of Chardon High School. We will gather in the front lobby while waiting to load the bus.
3. No one may enter the bus before the chaperone is on board and ready to check attendance.
4. Shouting/excessive noise will not be permitted during the trip. All school rules apply. It might be necessary for the driver or chaperone to give specific instructions.
5. Eat all refreshments while at Brandywine. No food or drink is permitted on the bus (this is a state law).
6. The bus will leave Brandywine at promptly 9:30 pm and return to Chardon High School around 10:30 pm. Please do not delay our scheduled departure time from Brandywine or you may be removed from the club on the first offense.
7. All students riding the bus to Brandywine must return on the bus. Anyone that does not ride the bus home without Miss Fisher's permission will have their bus privileges taken away and may lose their Brandywine pass with no refund (discretion of advisers and administration).
8. All normal school rules apply to the Chardon High School Ski/Board Club.

Note: Any infraction of the above rules or any school rule will be dealt with by a WARNING the first time and by REMOVAL from the club for the second offense. If it is considered a major school offense, dismissal from the club will be IMMEDIATE.

THE BOTTOM LINE:

Please remember that you represent Chardon, so embody the core values in the decisions you make on Tuesday evenings during the club time. Chardon High School Ski/Snowboard Club is to be fun for everyone and a hassle for no one!

Acknowledgement of Risk

I understand that skiing and snowboarding are hazardous sports that could lead to potential injury, serious injury, or even death. I acknowledge that I have been instructed that the Chardon High Ski/Board Club and Brandywine stress safety at the ski/board area, but that customers pay for and use the ski/board areas, facilities, and services with an understanding that that skiing/boarding is a hazardous sport, since hazards and obstructions exist in any ski/board area. I recognize that such hazards exist, whether marked or unmarked, that winter weather involves hazardous conditions, that falls and collisions are common and that injuries can and sometimes do result. I accept the hazards of the sport and the dangers of injuries incidental to skiing, snow boarding, including negligence on the part of fellow skiers and boarders.

I hereby release Chardon High School, Chardon High Ski/Board Club, the Chardon Board of Education, Boston Mills/Brandywine, their employees and instructors, Miss Fisher, and any sponsors or chaperones from any and all liability for injuries or any inconvenience sustained while enroute to Brandywine, while at Brandywine, or while enroute back to Chardon High School, or while waiting at Chardon High School. I understand that bindings will not under all circumstances prevent or reduce injury, and are not a guarantee of my safety. I agree to reimburse Brandywine for loss of or malicious damage to rental equipment.

I understand that I should not ski/board or ride any lift without previously receiving formal instruction from a Ski/Board School professional, and that beginner areas are clearly marked on maps of the slopes that are posted at the Brandywine lodge.

I hereby release Chardon High School, it's employees, chaperones, sponsors, and Miss Fisher from any liability or responsibility if I am not on the bus at the correct departure times when at school or at Brandywine.

Extracurricular Activities Academic Policy

The Board recognizes the value of extracurricular activities for the students of the district and for the community. However, student participation in extracurricular activities is a privilege and not a right.

As a condition for the privilege of participating in extracurricular activities, a student must maintain a minimum of a 1.5 GPA and not receive a grade of F in a course each (9) nine week grading period in order to maintain eligibility, practice, and/or participate. Eligibility for participation is determined by academic performance the preceding grading period. This standard will be effective for grades earned during second grading period. If a student who is ineligible under these standards improves his/her GPA enough during the current grading period to meet the eligibility standard, she/he may be reinstated at the beginning of the next grading period.
