**ATTENDANCE UPDATE**: Attendance is critical to student learning. With the recent passing of HB410 several changes have occurred. Absences are now calculated in hours, not days.

The law defines EXCESSIVE ABSENCE as a student who is:

- Absent 38 or more HOURS in a month WITH OR WITHOUT an excuse.
- Absent 65 or more hours in a YEAR with or without an excuse.

The law defines HABITUAL TRUANCY as a student who is:

- Absent 30 or more consecutive hours WITHOUT a legitimate excuse.
- Absent 42 or more hours in a month WITHOUT a legitimate excuse
- Absent 72 or more hours in a year WITHOUT a legitimate excuse.

In accordance with HB410, parent letters will be sent to identify attendance concerns and an Absence Intervention Plan will need to be implemented to encourage attendance and help foster the academic program.




### Attention Knitter, Crocheters, Loomers, and Crafters!
