A routine ultrasound during pregnancy revealed Camden had two holes in her heart. She received a feeding tube which she had until she was 3 years old. At 17 months old, doctors determined it was time to correct her condition with heart surgery. Camden is much better now. She has moderate hearing loss and wears hearing aids to compensate and visits her cardiologist annually for stress tests.
