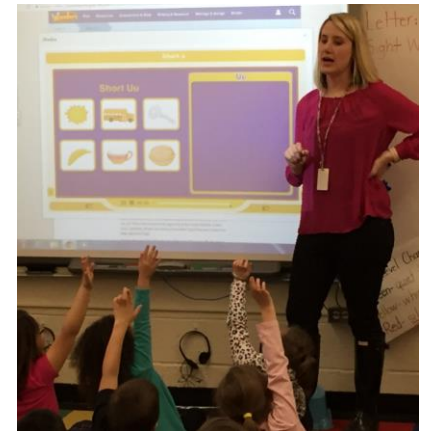
When can a student attend Chardon Kindergarten?



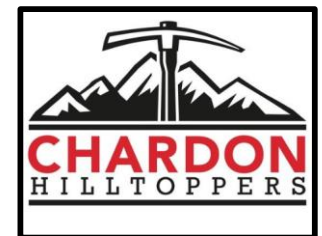
- Must be 5 on or before August 1st of the year they enter kindergarten.
- A parent may request early admission if birthday is between August 2-December 31 (early entrance testing required).

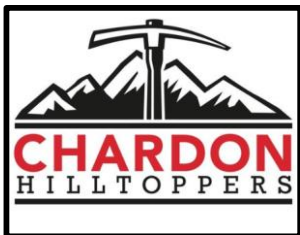
