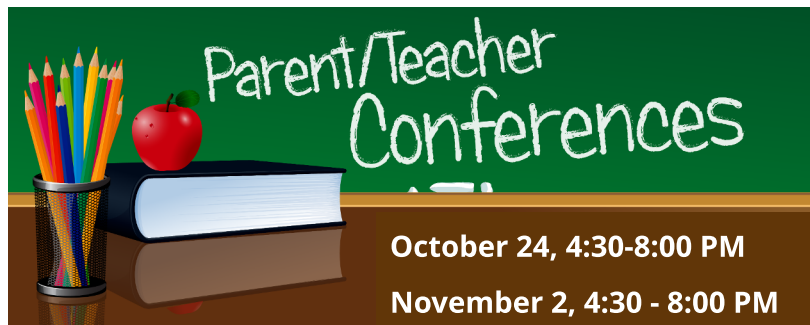

Thanks for sharing in the fun of this month's holiday.

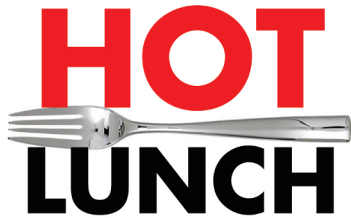

Halloween

Our classroom parties are scheduled for October 30 (KDG) and October 31 (1-5). This is still an instructional day, and festivities will not begin until 2:30 pm with the parade followed by the parties at 2:45pm.

The children are permitted to wear costumes for the parade and parties; however, costumes must be appropriate for school. Costumes **MUST** be in good taste without any blood, guts and gore or include any weapon or look-alike weapon of any kind. If a costume includes a mask, please make sure the eye holes are large enough to allow for proper vision and safety. Due to our time constraints, students are encouraged to wear clothing which will not require a complete outfit change. For example, blue jeans and a sport teams, jersey would be a good choice.

Make-up is discouraged. Please do not send your child to school with make-up already applied. If you question whether or not a costume is appropriate, it probably is not. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact the school office at 285-4065. We expect this to be a fun and safe time for all of the children. Weather permitting, the parade will extend outside. Feel free to come and watch. Only parents who are on the list for this party helpers will be allowed into the classrooms **NO** earlier than 2:15. **If you are taking your child(ren) home with you that day, please contact the school office that morning with a phone call or a note. Sign out will be in the MPR.**

BIRTHDAY TREATS & HOLIDAY PARTIES NEW POLICY IMPLEMENTATION

Birthday Treats:

- We understand that children get very excited about birthdays!
- We want to celebrate in a way that is safe for ALL students and staff.
- We hope to strike a balance between the sharing of treats and each family's right to monitor what their children eat at school.
- It is still our suggestion that you send in a non-food item to be shared. (ex: pencils, eraser ,stickers, or book /game for the classroom).
- If you choose to send in an edible treat please make sure that it is an individually pre-packaged and factory sealed snack that can easily be sent home with students as some classrooms have a no-outside food policy in place.
- Home-baked foods and treats are not permitted because of allergies and diet restrictions and therefore may be sent home with students in ziplock bags if ingredient and nutrition value cannot be identified.

Holiday Parties:

- Party food will consist of: a bottled water, an individually pre-packaged and factory sealed snack, and a fruit or vegetable side item for each child.
- A favor bag of non-edible treats is also permitted and will be sent home with students.
- Party food will be consistent amongst all the classrooms.
- Any outside food that is sent in on a party day (including candy for Halloween) will be held in the office. A good faith effort attempt to return it to the parent/ family who donated will be made.
