### **SPRING CARNIVAL UPDATE:**

There is a lot that happens during our Spring Carnival and things can get confusing when multiple requests for help are coming home. Here is a general rundown of areas of need and items requested:

- <u>Raffle Tickets</u> these came home with your student about a week ago. The raffle prizes are listed on the ticket and the winner DOES NOT need to be present to win. The winner is drawn during the auction portion of the carnival which begins at 3pm. If you are in need of more tickets, please contact the main office and more will be sent home.
- <u>**Classroom basket items</u>**: Each classroom has a different theme and these baskets are displayed at the auction in the auditorium. The tickets to try to win the baskets are sold during the carnival only and the winner MUST be present to win.</u>
- <u>**Classroom game helpers:</u>** Each classroom will have a game running during the carnival from 12:00-3:00 pm. The games are already assigned to each room and the PTO has all of the necessary parts of the games ready to go. We simply need people to help run the game during the event. Please contact your room parent to volunteer your time.</u>
- <u>Carnival helpers</u>: These are helpers necessary to run the rest of the event, outside of the games rooms. Areas of help needed are cafeteria, game ticket sales, raffle ticket sales, various concession areas, prize room helpers, set-up, and clean-up. Please click <u>HERE</u> to sign up.
- <u>Cakes, drinks, chips:</u> Two of the classroom run Cake-Walks for the game. We need around 100 baked items to operate the rooms. These cakes do not need to be fancy, store bought items from Marcs or Aldi are perfect options. Bottles of water, pop, juice boxes and chips are sold during the event in the cafeteria and other concession areas. Donations can be sent in the week of the event and a donation slip was sent home.

#### <u>A note for PTO events</u>

1. All children attending should be fever free for 24 HOURS, without the aid of fever lowering medications (Tylenol, Motrin)

2. Please do not bring children who are excessively sneezing or coughing. If you wouldn't want your child to be interacting with another child who is sneezing and/or coughing as much as yours is, it is a good sign your student shouldn't be there.

3. All children should be vomit and/or diarrhea free for 24 hours.

4. If your children just don't feel well enough to enjoy the event, please do not bring them.
