On Monday Sept 11, Hambden's guest speaker was Naturalist Deb Marcinski, a friend and former colleague of Mrs. Stickley. Over several weeks, Mrs. Stickley brought in Monarch eggs, caterpillars and chrsalis's. The students had a chance to see the eggs hatch, watch the caterpillars eat milkweed (their host plant) and grow. Eventually, the caterpillar shed its last skin and revealed a beautiful green chrysalis, complete with tiny gold spots. After 8-12 days, the chrysalis becomes clear, with the adult monarch butterfly showing thru this skin. Each time a monarch emerges from the chrysalis, it was given several hours to dry before being released to begin its journey to Mexico. The adult monarchs that we see in late Aug, Sept and October are all migrating to Mexico for the winter.


Monday Convocation
