This year's fun run will consist of students walking/running a course on Maple grounds. They will enjoy either a color zone finish or a bubble zone finish (based on parent/guardian permission). Permission slips and information for the "color zone" finish are attached!

Also attached is the Fun Run pledge sheet. Students should ask friends and family members to sponsor their run and make a pledge. Please turn in the form after you have collected all of your donations. **The due date is OCTOBER 24th** to be eligible for prizes! Many employers will match donations, remember to check with yours!

Maple Fun Run Permission Slip
October 6, 2017

The Fun Run Course will wind around the Maple property. Students will be given the option of a color zone finish with brightly colored powder used at "color runs" or they can choose a no color finish.

MORE INFORMATION ON THE COLOR ZONE FINISH:

The color zone will have volunteers who will toss non-toxic colored powder as the students cross the finish line. The volunteers will do their best to toss powder at the torso, but it is possible that wind and other factors could cause the powder to get on the face. Wearing goggles, sunglasses or other eye-wear will help to avoid getting powder in the eyes. The powder is non-toxic, consisting of corn starch and food grade color. **The color zone can be bypassed completely if a student does not wish to go through it.** The alternative finish is a bubble zone. A bubble machine will distribute a sea of bubbles. Bubble solution is peanut-free. Fun Run t-shirts will be provided.

TIPS FOR BEFORE ENTERING THE COLOR ZONE FINISH:

- Runners can wear a scarf or bandana to cover their mouth as they run through the color zone or to help wipe off colored powder after. Some people wear sunglasses or swim goggles.
- Though the color will eventually wash out of everything, please wear old clothing or clothes you will not mind getting "colored". Plastic baggies will be available for students wishing to tote their colored t-shirts home in a bag.

TIPS FOR AFTER THE COLOR ZONE FINISH:

- Dust off as much powder as you can before you apply any water. Most color should come right out.
- The color might not come all the way out of a white shirt. Just about everything else should be fine. Remove all excess powder before adding water.
- Wash your color run gear separately with COLD water. Oxiclean, or a similar product, work well.
- If the colored powder doesn't all come out on the first wash, eventually it will fade. SMILE! It will remind you how much fun you had on race day and how you helped our school!
