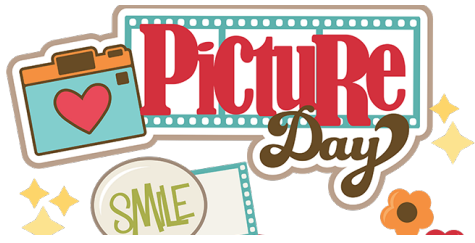


Maple Happenings

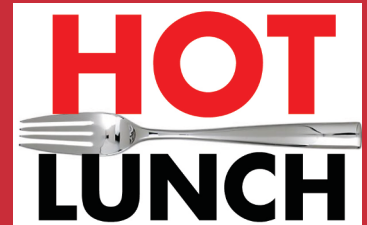

Birthday Treats & Holiday Parties

New Policy Implementation

Birthday Treats:

- We understand that children get very excited about birthdays!
- We want to celebrate in a way that is safe for ALL students and staff.
- We hope to strike a balance between the sharing of treats and each family's right to monitor what their children eat at school.
- It is still our suggestion that you send in a non-food item to be shared. (ex: pencils, eraser, stickers, or book/game for the classroom).
- If you choose to send in an edible treat please make sure that it is an individually pre-packaged and factory sealed snack that can easily be sent home with students as some classrooms have a no-outside food policy in place.
- Home-baked foods and treats are not permitted because of allergies and diet restrictions and therefore may be sent home with students in ziplock bags if ingredient and nutrition value cannot be identified.

Holiday Parties:

- Party food will consist of: a bottled water, an individually pre-packaged and factory sealed snack, and a fruit or vegetable side item for each child.
- A favor bag of non edible treats is also permitted and will be sent home with students.
- Party food will be consistent amongst all the classrooms.
- Any outside food that is sent in on a party day (including candy for Halloween) will be held in the office. A good faith effort attempt to return it to the parent/family who donated will be made.
- Valentines that include candy or gum are not permitted.
